



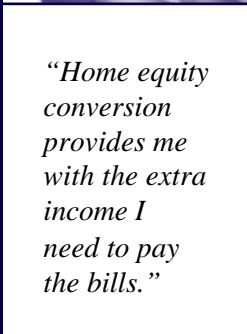

Homesharing Help and Information

HIP Housing’s Homesharing Program is a one-on-one service linking people who have housing to share with those seeking housing. Each person has a private room and shares common living areas. HIP Housing interviews clients and makes referrals to match people in housing.

Self-Sufficiency Program

HIP Housing’s Self-Sufficiency Program enables low-income families to transition to self-reliance. Participants receive subsidized rents or a housing scholarship while they complete an education or job training program and find employment with an adequate income to support their families.

Home Equity Conversion

HIP Housing’s Home Equity Conversion Program provides objective information and counseling on ways seniors can turn their accumulated home value into spendable cash so they can remain independent in their homes.

Property Development

Through Property Development HIP Housing expands the pool of affordable housing for low-income persons and families in San Mateo County by developing new and acquiring and rehabilitating existing housing.
